Amendment V

No person shall be held to answer for a capital, or otherwise infamous crime, unless on a presentment or indictment of a Grand Jury, except in cases arising in the land or naval forces, or in the Militia, when in actual service in time of War or public danger; nor shall any person be subject for the same offence to be twice put in jeopardy of life or limb; nor shall be compelled in any criminal case to be a witness against himself, nor be deprived of life, liberty, or property, without due process of law; nor shall private property be taken for public use, without just compensation.

Using data provided by the U.S. Census Bureau, the ACLU has determined that nearly 2/3 of the entire US population (197.4 million people) live within 100 miles of the US land and coastal borders.

The government is assuming extraordinary powers to stop and search individuals within this zone. This is not just about the border: This "

The ACLU Fact Sheet was written October 22, 2008 and provides some insight to the new Constitution Free Zone. What I did not see is a clear reference to where this originated. It does inform us that from the edge of our map defined border to one hundred miles inland, the Constitution Free Zone (CFZ) exists, which includes nine out of the ten of the major metropolitan areas which amounts to two thirds of the population of The United States. This is approximately 197.4 million people who have little or no idea of this treasonous act. These ten largest cities were determined by the 2000 census. ACLU [Fact Sheet on U.S. "Constitution Free Zone"](#)

Connecticut, Delaware, Florida, Hawaii, Maine, Massachusetts, Michigan, New Hampshire, New Jersey, New York, Rhode Island and Vermont are completely inside the Constitution Free Zone.

The Department of Homeland Security (DHS) claims authority to stop, search and detain anyone, for any reason, who is within the zone from the border to one hundred miles inland.

Congress authorized the DHS to operate within a “reasonable” distance of the border. This one hundred mile border was set by U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP),

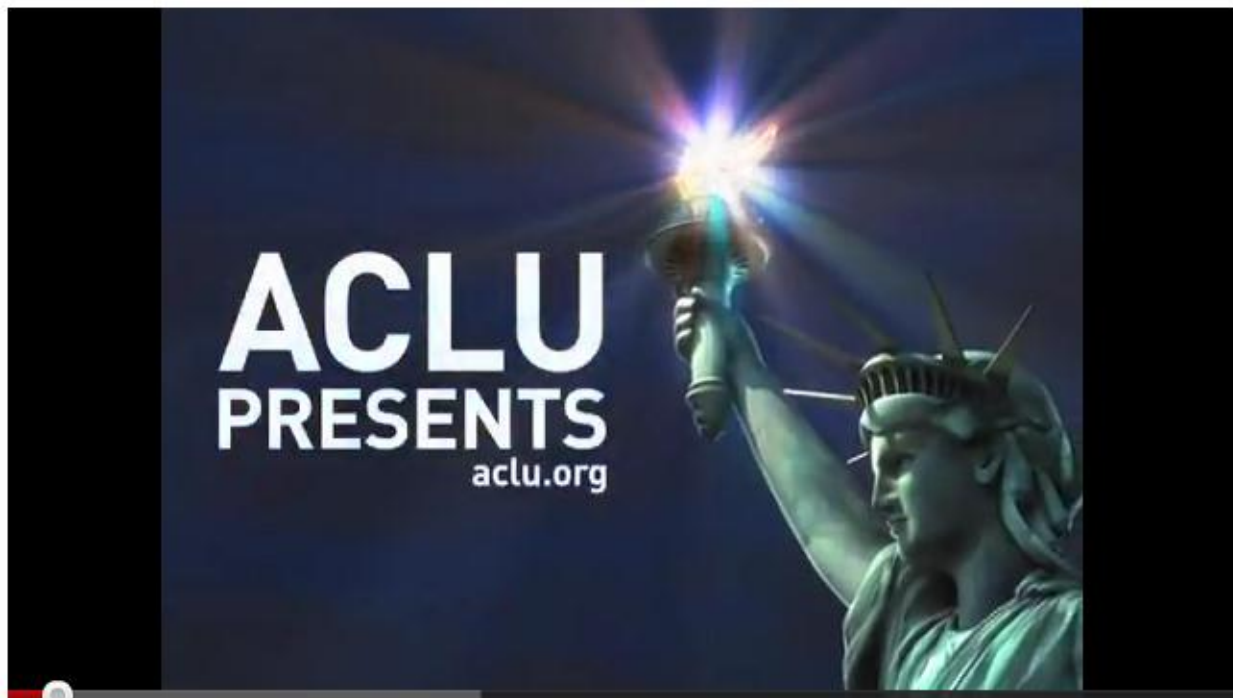

The author Nick Juliano states “DHS 33 "interior checkpoints" that are monitored by the border patrol, according to a [2005 Government Accountability Office report](#). The ACLU assumes more checkpoints have been established since then, and group affiliates have complained about checkpoints as far as 93 miles from the border.” I would check this publication to get the tone of the CBP and DHS.
